SUBJECT: Depot Partnering Data Requirements.

1. During the 17-19 Nov 03 Depot Partnering Meeting, representatives of Contractor Supported Weapon Systems (CSWS) requested an increase in information sharing with the government to facilitate depot partnering. The AF/IL and SAF/AQ "Acquisition and Logistics Policy for Contractor Managed Systems" Memorandum, 24 October 2003, specifies maintenance, materiel management, retail supply, transportation, and information data system policies that are targeted to attain combat readiness by developing the best government-contractor partnerships. Providing contractors with requested data will allow greater service in a cooperative environment. A discussion on contractors' data requirements highlighted the differences in each partnering situation; therefore, AF/ILGP is requesting input from all CSWS program offices to develop a standard list of data requirements that will satisfy those involved in partnering agreements.
2. Data elements were identified that provide status on parts throughout the repair process, shipment status, actual repair costs, and allow greater response in a partnering environment. Much of the requested information exists in government systems, and modifications to both the contractor and government systems would be a long-term solution to automate process flows and provide CSWS greater capabilities.
3. Each program office is asked to identify all information and data required by their contractors from the Air Force's Maintenance and Supply Systems to perform depot partnering. AF/ILGP will collect input from the program offices, develop a standard list of data elements, begin coordination, and integrate into future Depot Partnering guidance. During the next Depot Partnering meeting, the program offices' input will be covered as an agenda item. All input will be forwarded to AF/ILGP NLT 30 Jan 04.
